AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

ELIGIBILITY

- Applicant must be a 2019 graduate of Maui High School with a weighted cumulative high school grade point average of at least 3.30 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicant must complete the application and provide all required documents by the stated deadline. The Scholarship Judges reserve the right to request supplemental materials from any Applicant.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The Scholarship Judges' decision will be based on

- The Applicant's grade point average (20%);
- The Applicant's high school activities, awards, honors, employment, and community service activities (20%);
- A short essay (40%); and
- One letter of recommendation (20%).

All decisions by the Scholarship Judges are final.

The completed application packet which includes application, resume and letter of recommendation must be emailed to the Maui High School Foundation at foundation@mauihigh.org by 4:00 pm on March 29th, 2019. Application documents must be submitted in one PDF document. Please do not submit separate files.

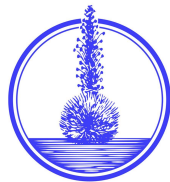
