AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The Maui High School Foundation's Scholarship Program is funded from various donations and/or activities held throughout the year. The 2020 ERYN-JOIE YOGI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP is funded by the Yogi Ohana. TWO \$1000 Scholarship will be awarded.

ELIGIBILITY

- Applicant must be a 2020 graduate of Maui High School with a weighted cumulative high school grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicant must complete the application and provide all required documents by the stated deadline. The Scholarship Judges reserve the right to request supplemental materials from any Applicant.
- Plan to continue his/her education at a recognized two or four year college, university or technical school

SELECTION CRITERIA

The Scholarship Judges’ decision will be based on

- The Applicant’s weighted cumulative grade point average (20%);
- The Applicant’s high school activities, awards, honors, employment, and community service activities (20%);
- Short Essay (40%); and
- One letter of recommendation (20%).

All decisions by the Scholarship Judges are final.
