MISSION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Maui High School Foundation promotes the pursuit of higher education by awarding scholarship grants to deserving seniors of Maui High School.

SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

The 2022 A & I REFRIGERATION SCHOLARSHIP is funded by A & I Refrigeration Sales and Service Inc. of Kahului, Maui. "We value students' hopes, dreams and aspirations. Our mission is to provide qualified and highly skilled workers trained to meet the challenges of rapid technological advancements. Hence, the purpose of this scholarship is to make the dream of college a reality for area students who wish to remain on Maui and who desire careers that will improve our community."

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

For 2022, the following are expected to be awarded: Two \$1,000 Scholarships.

ELIGIBILITY

- The applicant must be a 2022 graduate of Maui High School with a weighted cumulative high school grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- The applicant must be an Industrial & Engineering Technology program completer.
- The applicant must be planning to attend UH Maui College AND/OR plan to enroll in a Maui-based vocational/technical school or apprenticeship program.
- The applicant must complete the application and provide all required documents by the stated deadline.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The Scholarship Judges' decision will be based on

- The Applicant's weighted cumulative grade point average (20%);
- The Applicant's high school activities, awards, honors, employment, and community service activities (20%);
- An Interview with the judges (40%); and
- One letter of recommendation (20%).

INTERVIEW

An interview will be scheduled with all applicants after the March 11th application deadline. The interview will either be conducted at Maui High or virtually.

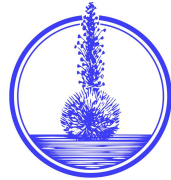
DEADLINE

The completed application packet (which includes application, resume, and letter of recommendation) must be emailed to the Maui High School Foundation at sabers@mauihighfoundation.com by 4:00 pm on Friday, March 11, 2022.

ABSOLUTELY NO EXTENSIONS OR EXCEPTIONS WILL BE GRANTED. All decisions by the Scholarship Judges are final.

SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

- Combine the completed application packet (which includes application, resume, and letter of recommendation) into one pdf document if possible. Name your application packet LASTNAME, FIRSTNAME - "Name of Scholarship"
 - Example : **Smith, Jennifer - Silversword Scholarship** (preferred)
- If you are not able to combine your pages into one pdf document, be sure to attach all Scholarship documents into the same email and submit them all together. Each attachment should be labeled appropriately.
 - Example of Separate Application Files : **Smith, Jennifer - Resume**
- Email application packet to sabers@mauihighschoolfoundation.com by the deadline.
 - Enter in the subject Line: LASTNAME, FIRSTNAME - "Name of Scholarship"
 - Example : **Smith, Jennifer - Silversowrd Scholarship**
- If you do not receive a confirmation email within 72 hours of submitting your application, send a follow up email to the Foundation.

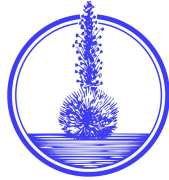
Please include the details indicated below in your letter of recommendation on behalf of the applicant.
