**MISSION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

The Maui High School Foundation promotes the pursuit of higher education by awarding scholarship grants to deserving seniors of Maui High School. The Athletic Scholarship aims to support Maui High student athletes who demonstrate leadership, sportsmanship, work ethic, and citizenship.

**SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS**

The Maui High School Foundation's Scholarship Program is funded from various donations and/or activities held throughout the year.

**AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIPS**

For 2022, the following are expected to be awarded: Two \$1000 Athletic Scholarships.

**ELIGIBILITY**

- The applicant must be a 2022 graduate of Maui High School with a weighted cumulative high school grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- The applicant must have participated in Maui High Athletics for a minimum of one season.
- The applicant must complete the application and provide all required documents by the stated deadline.
- The applicant must be planning to attend a 2 or 4 year college/university for Fall 2022.

**SELECTION CRITERIA**

The Scholarship Judges' decision will be based on

- The Applicant's weighted cumulative grade point average (20%);
- The Applicant's high school activities, awards, honors, employment, and community service activities (30%);
- A recorded video presentation submission (30%) and;
- Coach/AD Recommendation Form (20%).

**All decisions by the Scholarship Judges are final.**

## RECORDED VIDEO PRESENTATION INSTRUCTIONS

Applicants shall prepare a presentation to address the prompt for the scholarship. Each student who submits a completed application packet will be contacted by Maui High School Foundation to schedule a date and time to record the presentation. Applicants will receive up to 20-minutes to conduct a presentation. Applicants may conduct the presentation multiple times within the allotted time and select the best recording to submit. The presentation will be video recorded and forwarded without editing to the judges.

The presentation:

- Must be conducted and recorded at Maui High School during a scheduled time provided by Foundation's Scholarship Committee.
- Must be between 2min - 5min in length.
- Must include a brief introduction and address the presentation prompt.
- May include any medium of visual aids or props including screen share of image, audio, video, slides or any combination thereof.

Athletic Scholarship Recorded Video Presentation Prompts (please address all points):

- How has being a part of the Maui High Athletics program influenced you and helped shape the person today?
- Give a specific example of personal growth during your time in the Athletics program.
- Share a little bit of your future plans and how you might apply skills you've developed through Athletics to better the world around you.

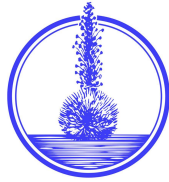

- Combine the completed application packet (which includes application, resume, and letter of recommendation) into one pdf document if possible. Name your application packet LASTNAME, FIRSTNAME - "Name of Scholarship"
  - Example : **Smith, Jennifer - Silversword Scholarship** (preferred)
- If you are not able to combine your pages into one pdf document, be sure to attach all Scholarship documents into the same email and submit them all together. Each attachment should be labeled appropriately.
  - Example of Separate Application Files : **Smith, Jennifer - Resume**

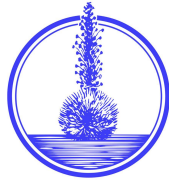
