AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

- Applicant must be a 2018 graduate of Maui High School with a cumulative high school grade point average of at least 3.30 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicant must complete the application and provide all required documents by the stated deadline. The Scholarship Judges reserve the right to request supplemental materials from any Applicant.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The Scholarship Judges' decision will be based on

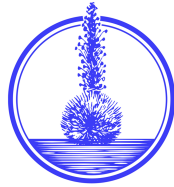
- The Applicant's grade point average (20%);
- The Applicant's high school activities, awards, honors, employment, and community service activities (20%);
- A short essay (40%); and
- Two letters of recommendation (20%).

All decisions by the Scholarship Judges are final.

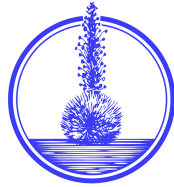

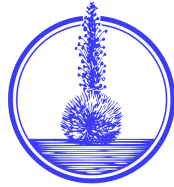
